

# 2018 TWILIGHT LEAGUE SCENARIOS, RULES & DECISIONS

## • Signing Up for the League

- League sign-ups are posted online. Twilight is open to all (full golf male) members, the first 80 or 96 members to sign-up for the league are in. (8 teams of 10 or 12)
- The remaining members may be placed on the sub-list
- Members may ask the Golf Shop staff to sign them up, the Golf Shop staff then must go online and sign them up there

#### Draft

- o The draft takes place 2 Sundays before the 1<sup>st</sup> league night (April 22<sup>nd</sup>)
- Captains pick teams using the "snake" team selection
- o Captains will review and sign the rules sheet for that year
- Teams will be posted immediately following the captains meeting along with the rules and decisions sheet
- The sub list will also be posted with contact information

# Setting Up for League

- Using the "bag list" the staff will set up all of the members bags, by team, in the grass between the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and 9<sup>th</sup> green. This will be done from 1PM – 2PM.
- o If there is a chance of rain, the bags will be set up inside

#### • The First Tee

- The tee may be run by Brian Moskevich or another Golf Professional on staff
- Once all 4 members of the group arrive, the MCC staff member will put them "on the tee sheet".
- o The 1<sup>st</sup> tee is closed starting at 1 PM for 18 hole rounds and 2:50 for 9 holes
- o Twilight Tees off between 3 6 PM

#### Subs

- Number of times a regular member may use a sub: Not limited
- Handicap system for the subs:
  - -Substitutes within 1 stroke (9 hole handicap) of the player they are subbing for will play straight up in the individual and team match. If the sub is out of the 1 stroke range, 9 hole handicaps will be used to determine strokes in the individual match. Subs with higher handicaps will always play straight up in

- the team portion of the match. No strokes will be given. In the event that a substitute has a lower handicap then everyone in the group (outside of the 1 stroke range) everyone will stroke off that player in the team match.
- Notify the MCC staff member running the league to get the proper strokes before the group tees off
- o If a regular needs a sub, it is their responsibility to go to the sub list and find a sub
- The sub does not have to come from the sub list, it is just a resource set aside for convenience.

#### Local Rules

- What tees are played: players 1-2 will play the black tees, players 3-4 will play the blue tees, players 5-10 will play white
- Preferred lies in the fairway: Decision will be made by professional staff before play

#### Scoring

- One member from each match must report the results of the match to the MCC golf staff member
- That member must then initial next to the spot where the score is recorded
- Any disputes in scoring will be directed towards the member who reported the score

## Re-scheduling matches

 No rescheduling. Matches must be played on the Tuesday they are scheduled

#### Inclement Weather Policy

- o The golf shop staff will suspend
- o Course conditions unplayable, standing water on the greens
- Lightning causing the course to be cleared (unsafe playing conditions)
- o Only 1 week may be rescheduled due to rain

### Member Having to Withdraw from Twilight / Member not showing up

- o Injury or other circumstances? Player must find appropriate sub
- o Finding a permanent sub/replacement for the remainder of the season
- What is the penalty for a member who does not show up for a match? Loss of match
