



## 2019 JOE MAKARA MEMBER-MEMBER

### *Rule Sheet*

- › Three-day Team Match Play. Matches played will be best ball one of two, net. 100% of Handicaps will be used.
- › The event will consist of eight, eight-team flights determined by a total team handicap index.
- › Partners will have a maximum handicap differential of eight. Teams that exceed the differential will have the higher handicap cut to meet the requirement.
- › Each team will play seven 9-hole matches against each team in their respective flight.
  - Friday will consist of three 9-hole matches
  - Saturday and Sunday will consist of two 9-hole matches
- › Tees
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> flight will compete from the **Black Tees**
  - The 2<sup>nd</sup> flight will compete from the **Blue Tees**
  - All other flights will compete from the **White Tees**
  - All flights will alternate 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Tee starts between matches one, two, etc.
  - During the "March" **all** teams will play from the **White Tees**
- › The scoring in each match **per hole** is based on the following:
  - One point for a win
  - Half point for a tie
  - Zero points for a loss
- › Total points won will determine the match, daily, and tournament results.
- › The maximum amount of points that can be won in one 9-hole match is seven points.
- › In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place at the end the seventh 9-hole match, the first tie break will be determined by the results of the head-to-head match. The second tie break will be determined by a "chip-off." Player will be picked by each team. All other ties after head-to-head will split winnings.
- › A "March" will be used to determine the overall winner of the Makara Member-Member Tournament. The format of the "March" is Alternate Shot (Alternating Tee Boxes), all teams playing from the White Tees. Team handicaps are totaled and divided by 2. Strokes are given off low team total. Flights 1-4 will begin the "March" off #1 and Flights 5-8 will begin on #10. One team will be eliminated from each hole until a winner is determined. Tie break for elimination holes will be determined by a "chip-off." One player will be picked by each team. Ties for the 18<sup>th</sup> hole will be replayed twice and "chip-off" in the event of a third tie.
- › Ground Under Repair will be indicated by white painted circles. If the player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under rule 25-1.
- › Rain
  - In the event of rain or inclement weather all teams in the flight must have the same number of matches completed.
  - If play is stopped due to weather or darkness please mark the ball with tees so that the position of ball can be easily duplicated.
- › The "Committee" consists of PGA Director of Golf Jeff May, PGA Head Golf Professional Brian Moskevich, PGA CCM General Manager Brian Kelley, Golf Committee and Chair Pat Caveny. All decisions made by the "Committee" are final.
- › Unrestricted Full Golf and Young Executive members are eligible for this tournament. All others will be admitted on an availability basis only.
- › Field is limited to 64 two-man teams and all entries are based on seniority.
  - If sign ups exceed the limit, entries are determined by:
    - o Team combined total years of membership;
    - o Membership application date of each team's most senior member
  - If the field is not filled by the closing date:
    - o All subsequent entries are determined by the date of sign up.
    - o Teams entering prior to the closing date cannot be bumped by teams entering after the closing date (only if the field is NOT filled by the closing date).
