

# 2024 MEN'S TWILIGHT LEAGUE

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Twilight League will begin Tuesday, April 30 and will run for seven (7) weeks through Tuesday, June 18.
  - o Rain Date: Tuesday, June 25
- League will begin at 3:00 p.m. every Tuesday afternoon and run until 6:00 p.m.
- Consists of 9-Hole matches and will utilize both the front nine and the back nine.
  - o The tee will be closed to non-league golfers from the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. every Tuesday.
- The first and final night will be a shotgun start at 4:00 p.m. with an awards banquet to follow on the final night. All other weeks will operate under tee times.
- Tee times will be sent out to all league participants before the first week of play.

### REGISTRATION

- Registration will be open for 24 hours, and the final roster will be based on a lottery system.
- The league will consist of eight 10-man teams with one captain on each team. The captain will be responsible for making sure that all of the matches are played each week.
- Full-time players should commit to playing for 7 weeks or choose to be a substitute. If you are unable to make a minimum of six weeks, please sign up as a substitute.

## **FORMAT**

- Players 1-2 from each team will play the black tees, players 3-4 will play the blue tees, and players 5-10 will
  play the white tees.
- All matches played will be match play.
- The matches will be one player vs. one player matches and also team vs. team. Example: Player 1 from team 7 would play Player 1 from team 8 if that was that week's set matchup. Teams will alternate from the front nine to the back nine on a week-to-week basis.

#### **SCORING**

- There will be a total of 3 points to be won per foursome.
  - o 1 point will be awarded to the winner of the individual match (ex. Player 1 vs. Player 1).
  - o 1 point will also be awarded for the result of the team match (ex. Player 1 and Player 2 vs. Player 1 and Player 2 from the opposing team).
  - o 1½ points (the maximum a player can win) will be awarded if both players win their individual matches and their team match.
  - o 1¼ points will be awarded if both players win their individual match but half the team match. 1 point will be awarded for an individual win but a team loss. At the conclusion of the seven-week period, the team that has collected the most points will be determined the winner.

In the event of a player substitution, 9-hole handicaps will be used to determine the stroke differential between opponents.

The absent player's responsible for finding a replacement for the match he misses and informing the captain of his absence.
