

2020 JOE MAKARA MEMBER-MEMBER *rule sheet*

- › Three-day Team Play. One best ball of two Stableford, net. 90% of Handicaps will be used.
- › The event will consist of eight, ten-team flights determined by a total team handicap index.
- › Partners will have a maximum handicap differential of eight. Teams that exceed the differential will have the higher handicap cut to meet the requirement. June 5 handicaps will be used for the tournament.
- › Each team will play 54-holes over the course of three days.
 - Friday will consist of 18-holes
 - Saturday and Sunday will consist will consist of 18 holes (second and third round pairings will be based off previous round scores)
- › Tees
 - The 1st flight will compete from the **Black** Tees
 - The 2nd and 3rd flight will compete from the **Blue** Tees
 - All other flights will compete from the **White** Tees
- › The scoring in each round is based on the following:
 - (1) Points Net Double Bogey or Worse
 - 0 Points Net Bogey
 - 1 Point Net Par
 - 2 Points Net Birdie
 - 4 Points Net Eagle
 - 8 Points Net Double Eagle
- › In the event of a tie for 1st place in the flight, the USGA method will be used to break the tie. All other ties will split the winnings.
- › Ground Under Repair will be indicated by white painted circles. If the player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under rule 16-1. Relief may also be taken from newly removed stumps throughout the course. Relief will be granted from all sod seams throughout the course.
- › USGA defines a "ball holed" must be at rest below the surface of the cup. A ball wedged between the surfaces of the cup is deemed holed without having to move the flagstick. A ball that appears to be going in but does not after hitting the device used to lift the ball from the cup cannot be considered holed.
- › Preferred lies in all bunkers
- › Hole #8 – white painted areas mark "**Ground Under Repair**," balls found within these areas get free relief. Any ball not found is considered lost & players must proceed under USGA rules for "Lost Ball" which is stroke and distance.
- › Contests
 - Optional Team Game \$100 buy in per team (cash). Pays out top 3 in each flight.
 - Optional Skins Game \$100 buy in per team (weekend skins)
 - Closest to hole contests
- › Rain
 - In the event of rain or inclement weather all teams in the flight must have the same number of matches completed.
 - If play is stopped due to weather or darkness please mark the ball with tees so that the position of ball can be easily duplicated.
- › The "Committee" consists of PGA Director of Golf Jeff May, PGA Head Golf Professional Brian Moskevich, PGA CCM General Manager Brian Kelley, Golf Committee and Chair Dan Monfried. All decisions made by the "Committee" are final.
